We would like to remind parents that PE is an important part of the school curriculum and it is not optional. Please ensure that your child has their full PE kit on their PE day. They must come to school in full school uniform and bring their kit to get changed into. If your child has a significant injury which prevents them from taking part, you must send a letter or email to school explaining this.

Promoting children's independence

It is important that all children are given the support they need to become confident and independent. Parents can help with this in the following ways:

- Involve children in packing their own bags and getting their uniform ready for the day
- Encourage children to carry their own bags
- Help children to learn how to dress themselves, including tying shoelaces and patkas
- Set a routine for homework children should know when they can sit down to complete their homework every evening
- Expect children to feed themselves independently, including using a knife, fork and spoon.

- Only black or navy blue tights or full-length leggings
- Small stud earrings only
- Patkas must be worn every day
