Parents' driving – children's safety

- Stopping in the middle of the road to let your child out into the road
- Overtaking on the zebra crossing
- Stopping on the zigzag lines
- Doing a three-point turn into the school's driveway
- Being verbally abusive to other drivers or school staff
- Parking on or across residents' driveways

Unless you live a significant distance away from school, please consider using another method of travel. The number of cars on the road, especially those driving and parking in an illegal way, is putting children's lives at risk.
